I had wanted to send this before, but it has been a mess before Christmas. My husband's mother had broken her femur and at 88 years has healed completely, but we're always busy because she lives far away from our little quaint village in the middle of nowhere. Anyway, I'm sending the CD with just the main views of the right hand figure, including one with a facsimile of one of the walls. As soon as I get your approval, I'll take the model in Plasticine to the Foundry and have it cast. Then I will let you know what a retainer fee could be up to now, also calculating the exchange rate in Euros, unfortunately. This figure is of a Caucasian, European type American 12/13 yr. old, a little longer-legged than normal so the low wall in front does not optically shorten the figure. Hope you like it. Otherwise let me know if you have any suggestions.

Hope your mom is well and that you had a relaxing Christmas and will have had a good beginning for the new year.
